


SEE THE LIGHT? WE CAN HELP

Check it out. A TPMS system check is as easy as getting into your car and turning your ignition on. If your TPMS indicator light turns off, you're on your way. If it remains on or flashes, you may have an issue:



FLASHING TPMS LIGHT

You have a system failure and more than likely a bad sensor. Have a service professional check it out.



SOLID TPMS LIGHT

If your light stays on, check your tires for proper inflation or damage.
